Bearcat BEST Latrobe, PA

Bearcat BEST - Building Excellence through Skills Training - is a program located out near Pittsburgh for students who live in the area that are between the ages of 18 and 21.



Career Studies Middletown, PA



Career Studies offers students with intellectual disabilities the opportunity to participate in inclusive learning environments on a college campus.

- For 18-25 year olds
- 2 year, 4 semester program audit a minimum of 1 class per semester
- Customer relations coursework with the opportunity to earn the National Retail Foundation certificate

Career, Independent Living, and Learning Studies (CILLS) East Stroudsburg, PA

CILLS is non-degree program where individuals with intellectual disabilities gain a college experience and develop skills to enhance their abilities to live and work within their communities.

Compass Pittsburgh, PA



Compass is a fully inclusive post-secondary four year certificate program for students who are enthusiastic about the opportunity to pursue curricular, vocational, and social opportunities at college as a means in which to develop independence and future careers.


L&CS provides students with an authentic college experience developing academic abilities, career aspirations, and independence.


Leadership & Integrative Studies Lock Haven. PA
